BY THE TIME THIS ISSUE OF THE JUG HITS THE STREET, THE 1980 SS WILL BE HISTORY. IT IS TOO EARLY TO MAKE A CLUB SCORE PREDICTION, BUT IT APPEARS THAT FOR THE CW WEEKEND BOTH PARTICIPATION AND INDIVIDUAL SCORES WERE DOWN FROM LAST YEAR'S RECORD SETTING EFFORT. HOPEFULLY THINGS WILL HAVE PICKED UP FOR THE SSB WEEKEND. BE SURE TO MAIL YOUR RESULTS TO ARRL BEFORE DEC.16, WE NEED THEM ALL. SEND A COPY OF YOUR SUMMARY SHEET TO BOB, N6TV ASAP. BE SURE TO MARK NCCC IN YOUR SUMMARY SHEET.

DENNIS, N6QW REPORTS THAT ALL 58 COUNTIES WERE ACTIVE IN CQP ALTHOUGH NO-ONE WORKED THEM ALL. CQP WAS INDEED A GOOD CLUB EFFORT.

THE NEXT BIG CONTEST EVENT FOR THE NCCC IS THE ARRL DX CONTEST. NO ONE WILL WANT TO MISS THIS ONE SINCE IT MAY BE THE LAST MAJOR CONTEST WITH EXCELLENT PROPAGATION CONDITIONS BEFORE THE SUNSPOT CYCLE ROLLS AROUND.

I PARTICULARLY WOULD LIKE TO THANK THE FOLLOWING NCCC AREA COORDINATORS FOR A JOB WELL DONE. WITHOUT THEIR HELP THIS ENTIRE SS EFFORT COULD NOT HAVE TAKEN PLACE. WITH THE SS BEHIND US, IT'S TIME TO START LOOKING AHEAD TO THE 1981 ARRL DX CONTEST. THIS YEAR, IN ORDER TO BOOST THE CLUB'S AGGREGATE SCORE, WE WILL BE USING "INTRA-CLUB" TEAM COMPETITION. THIS IS HOW IT WILL WORK: THE CLUB WILL BE DIVIDED, AT RANDOM, INTO THREE OR FOUR TEAMS OF EQUAL SIZE. EVERY CLUB MEMBER WILL BE PLACED ON A TEAM. EACH TEAM WILL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COVERING EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES WITH AS MANY STATIONS AS POSSIBLE: UNLIMITED MULTI/MULTI; 2 MAN MULTI/MULTI; MULTI/SINGLE; SINGLE-OP, ALL BAND; SINGLE-BAND 160 THROUGH 10; SINGLE-OP LOW POWER. POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE FINISHERS IN EACH CATEGORY, AND THE TEAM WITH THE MOST POINTS WINS THE COMPETITION. NONE OF THESE RULES HAVE BEEN FINALIZED, AND THE DETAILED POINT SCORING HAS YET TO BE WORKED OUT. LET ME HAVE YOUR IDEAS AT THE NOV. MEETING OR CONTACT ME BY PHONE, MAIL, OR RADIO.
