PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BY LAWS

ARTICLE VIII -FEES AND ASSESSMENTS, SECTION 1 TO BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

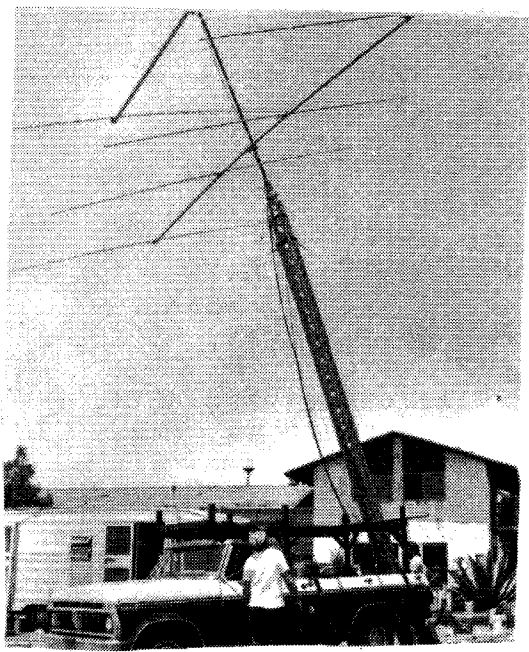

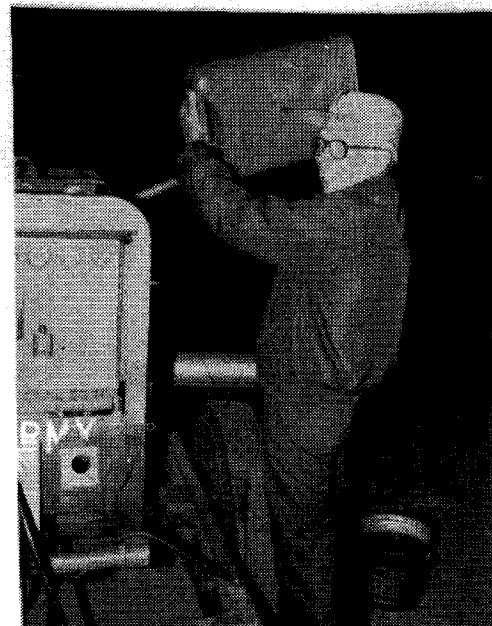

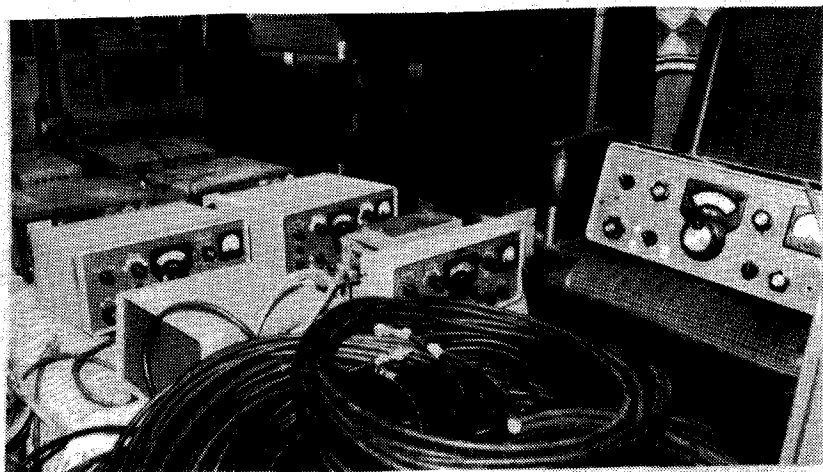

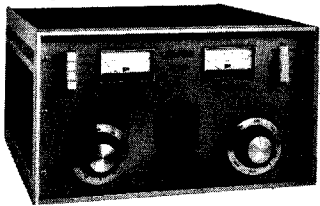
CLUB BUSINESS

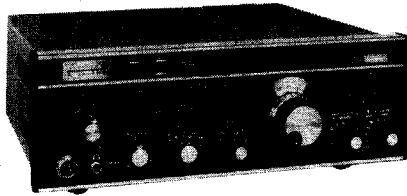

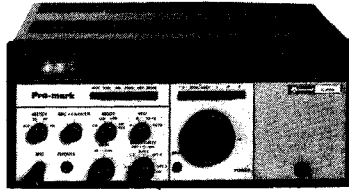
