1995 California QSO Party Results

The worldwide participation in the CQP again signaled the start of the fall contest season! While log submissions dropped a bit from last years record high, log submissions did tie the old 2nd place record with 413 logs received. The upward trend in activity is unmistakable, for top entries from California increased their QSO totals by over 10 percent. According to Ken, K6PU, who did a great job on getting the results out in super time, says that with the increased activity, we will need to start thinking about streamlining the log review process so we can accommodate the additional logs that are sure to show up when conditions improve in the next few years.

After reviewing the logs, it would be fair to say that the decline from last years record high in log submissions was directly proportional to propagation. While conditions held up throughout the

USA, DX conditions just weren't there. DX log submissions were down 16 from last year, which accounted for 30% of the difference between total logs received in 1994 and 1995. And the lack of conditions on 10m had its impact, for there were no Novice/ Technician entries from inside or out of California. But just wait till 1996 when conditions should be on the upswing!

But poor conditions didn't influence participants excitement and commitment to the contest! All 58 of the states and provinces were out in force this year, with 26 California logs showing clean sweeps. We Californians sure appreciate the efforts made outside of the Golden State! A big thanks to Bob, N6TV, who organized all 58 California counties to be on the air - though it seems that a bit of arm twisting had to be exerted, since the number of county expeditions went up from last year. All this activity sure showed up in the logs, for 12 new records went in the history books, 5 from California, 6 from the lower 48, and 1 DX record was also set. Great efforts by everyone!

Ken, AB6FO, repeated his top S/O honors this year. Close examination of the results will show that W1FEA/6 and W6REC had more QSOs than Ken, but Ken's CW QSOs locked in the number one slot. Top CA M/S honors again go to the gang at W6EEN, though they had fierce competition this year from the group at WB6IRC. I'd say there's gonna be another shoot'in match next year since the scores were very close, and M/S submissions increased by 40 percent over last year. Top CA M/M honors go to the group at KM6OH, who had a huge improvement over their last years effort - could it be that their M/M county expedition to Mono county was the difference?

AA6KX again took top S/O expedition, and took 7th overall in CA - what a great effort Bruce! The Shasta DX & Contest Club again took top club honors. W6UQF again repeated his S/O low power win. These guys sure are serious about the CQP, for they held a dynasty in the most prestigious categories. They are definitely the ones to beat in 1996

Top S/O non-CA honors go to NB1B, who also broke his old Massachusetts record along the way. Top non-CA M/S honors go to the group at KB9CEQ, and there were no non-CA M/M entries. AA8AV again repeated his top non-CA S/O low power win - what a fine effort!

This year some of the new CA records weren't just broken, they were smashed! WA6FGV from Tulare County came in with 156K vs. the old record of 89K. And AA6KX's county expedition to the Trinity/Shasta line nearly doubled the old Trinity record. KI4HN and N2AA increased their state records by 50%. This goes to show you that with a decent effort (even at the bottom of the cycle), your place in the CQP history books is still there for the taking.

The NCCC awards committee is busy getting ready for the awards banquet in March (be sure to make your reservation for the awards banquet - information can be found in this issue). If you miss the awards banquet but will be going to Visalia, please try and pick up your awards there and help us save on our postage expenses. Fm Ken WM2C

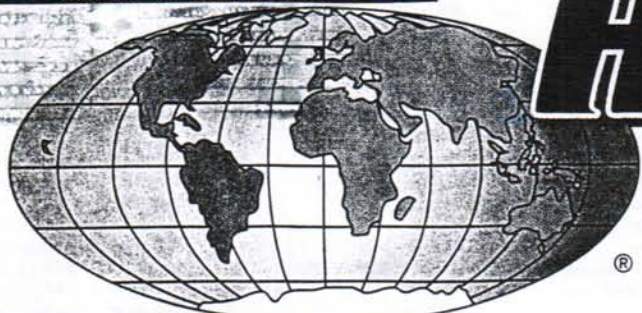
